Hi Kathie,

I know I haven't been as responsive to your emails over the past few weeks. My attention has been focused on several priorities, including preparation of the staff report and the recent Study Session.

I did want to address the question you highlighted in bold in your previous email regarding the event lists provided to SLOPD by CPPD. Code Enforcement was not aware that these event lists were being provided to SLOPD until you brought it to my attention in April of this year. Christine Wallace serves as Code Enforcement's primary liaison with SLOPD, and she has advised me that she was also unaware of these lists. The lists were provided to the Patrol Division and were not distributed to Christine or to Code Enforcement.

After reviewing the records provided as part of your public records request, it appears that the majority of the events would have been included in the 2022–2023 AB 524 report, which at that time included addresses and would have been incorporated into our enforcement efforts in early 2024. However, there are a few months' worth of events before and after the 2022–2023 academic year that were not captured due to the disconnect in communication between the Patrol Division and Code Enforcement.
